1. Information We Collect

We collect only the personal information necessary to provide our custom design, fabrication, and installation services, including:

- Payment Information: Billing details required to process payments (we do not store full credit card numbers; payments are handled securely by trusted third-party processors).
- Technical Data: Basic website usage data, such as IP address, browser type, device information, and pages viewed, to ensure site functionality, security, and performance.

We do not collect sensitive personal information (e.g., health data or biometric data) unless directly relevant to a custom project and provided voluntarily.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your information solely to:

- Provide quotations, custom design consultations, fabrication, delivery, and installation services.
- Communicate regarding orders, project updates, timelines, and customer support.
- Process payments and manage transactions.
- Improve our website, products, services, and internal processes.
- Comply with legal, tax, accounting, and warranty obligations.

Future Advertising We do not currently use cookies or other technologies for targeted advertising or tracking across websites. If we introduce such features in the future, we will update this Policy and provide appropriate notice and choices.

3. How We Share Your Information

We do not sell your personal information to third parties. We may share it only in limited circumstances:

- **Service Providers:** With trusted vendors who help with payment processing, shipping/logistics, installation, IT hosting, or customer support (these parties are contractually required to protect your data).
- **Legal Requirements:** If required by law, subpoena, court order, or to protect our rights, safety, or property.
- **Business Transfers:** In the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, your information may be transferred (with notice where required).
